Your long-term services and supports and other Medicaid services will be included in the health plan covered benefits. If you have Medicare or Medicare Advantage, that will be your primary health insurance. <h2 style="text-align: center;">Connect Care Choice Community Partners</h2>	<p>You may be eligible for Connect Care Choice <i>Community Partners</i>, if your doctor participates in the program. In addition to having a nurse care manager and your doctor for your medical needs, Connect Care Choice <i>Community Partners</i> helps with coordinating your long-term services and supports. There is also a Community Health Team that can help you find other services and programs in your community. If you have Medicare or Medicare Advantage, that will be your primary health insurance. Your Part D Prescription Drug plan will not change.</p> <p>See page 2 for a list of doctors' offices that participate.</p>
	<p>You may be eligible for PACE if you are 55 years old or older and have chronic health care needs. PACE will coordinate and provide all your needed medical and long-term services and supports. PACE will work with you and your family to develop a plan of care that meets your needs.</p> <p>See page 2 for more information on PACE.</p>

## Frequently Asked Questions

### **Do I have to enroll in one of these programs - Rhody Health Options, Connect Care Choice *Community Partners* or PACE ?**

No. Enrollment is voluntary but we will automatically enroll you in one of the new programs unless you tell us not to. Please be sure to select the program you would like by the date on the letter.

### **If I pick Rhody Health Options, Connect Care Choice *Community Partners* or PACE, will I have to pay more?**

No, your payment will not change.

### **Can I keep my doctor and specialists that I currently see?**

Yes, in most cases, you can keep the doctors you currently have.

### **What are Long-Term Services and Supports?**

Long-term services and supports include home and community-based services and nursing home care. Home and Community Based Services are: homemaker services, Certified Nursing Assistant (CNA) services, personal care, environmental home modifications, special medical equipment, Meals on Wheels, Personal Emergency Response Systems, case management, Senior Companion, Assisted Living, respite, minor assistance devices, Personal Choice Program (a self-directed program), RIt@Home (a Shared Living Program).

### **Are Adult Day Health Center services covered in Medicaid?**

Yes.

### **What if I get personal care through a home care agency (or any other home and community-based service)? Will that change?**

All the Medicaid services that you currently receive will continue after your enrollment date until they are re-authorized. The services you receive are based on your needs, so everyone's services and how much they receive will be different.

### **After I pick a Rhody Health Options health plan, Connect Care Choice *Community Partners* or PACE, can I switch later?**

Yes. Enrollment is done monthly so you can switch if you need to.

### **What do I do with my ID cards that I currently have?**

Continue to use and keep all of your ID cards. You will get a new ID card if you choose a Rhody Health Options or PACE.

### **What if I receive behavioral health services (mental health/ substance abuse)? Will I still get those services?**

Yes, all behavioral health services (mental health/ substance abuse) from your Community Mental Health Center or BHDDH licensed provider will continue.
